Lindenhurst Area Soccer Club (LASC) is looking for a new Director of Training to oversee all soccer and training operations, helping to drive a successful youth soccer program.

## Job Summary

The Director of Training (DOT) is our top trainer and head of all soccer related instruction and development for the Lindenhurst Area Soccer Club. The DOT should be a highly motivated, dedicated leader with strong interpersonal skills. This position is required to attend Board meetings; this is not a position that holds a vote on the Board. This position works directly under the supervision of the Board of Directors. This job is part time, approximately 20-30 hours per week depending on the time of year. The job is based in Lindenhurst, IL

## Key job requirements

- Drive and manage LASC training programs to maximize club success and experience for all of our players
- Develop programs and training philosophy
  - Example Futsal program, summer camp, training philosophy, winter programs, tournaments
- Manage all soccer operations
  - Approx 8-10 staff trainers – selection, hiring, and development
  - Approx 25 volunteer coaches – selection and development
  - Approx 280 players in 2019/2020 season – 160 girls and 120 or so boys from ages U8 through U19
- Manage tryouts process and team formation, placement into various leagues (IWSL, NISL, USSL)
- Attend all board meetings & present on training and soccer operations (approx 12 meetings per year, 1.5 hrs per meeting)
- Train up to 2 teams as needed
- Practice scheduling – manage and delegate via team formation

## Qualifications we are looking for:

- Required: five years' experience coaching Youth Soccer.
- Required: USSF E License or NSCAA Advanced National however USSF D or C or interest to attain that level will be preferred.
- Previous experience as a DoT or Assistant DoT preferred but not required.
- Professional or college level playing experience is strongly preferred.
- Bachelor's Degree is strongly preferred.
- Must have excellent verbal and written communication skills; ability to interact productively and positively with other trainers, coaches, parents, and players
- Must have excellent computer skills, including Word, Excel, PowerPoint, etc.
- Must be able to work flexible schedules including weekends, nights, and holidays
- Must be high integrity, positive and proactive mindset with the ability to drive and implement best practices working in tandem with the LASC Board and its stakeholders (Coaches/Trainers/Parents/Players etc)
